#### Instructions:

**1.** Open and Login on to the iSolarcloud Account. Click the "+" sign button on the upper right corner.

2. Click Plant Information and Fill up the required information.

Once everything is filled up, Save and Continue.

Note: "Plant Type" selection depends on the inverter model SG – Residential Inverter (regardless of size as long as it's not "CX" inverters) SH – Residential Hybrid (regardless if there's a battery or none) SG"**CX**" – Commercial Inverter

3. Scan the QR code of the dongle and Click "Confirm"

- 4. Select "Network".
- 5. Select the Correct WLan. Make sure it's 2.4Ghz Enter the password and click confirm
- 6. Activate "Easy Connect" will pop up, Click the dongle button "Once" make sure, WLan is rapidly flashing, then hit Continue.
- 7. Wait until the network has a "green tick"



**8.** Wait until your plant gets online. Once online, you will see a "green tick" on the upper left corner.

Note: System will be online depending on the internet connection, it may take a couple of minutes before it appears online.  $\mathbb{E}$
